HOW TO USE THIS GRADUATE SCHEDULE

1. Study your program requirements

Please check the Graduate Programs brochure, or visit www.webster.nl for a complete list of the required courses for your degree.

2. Select the rest of your courses to complete your program

Select the remainder of your courses from the other non-required courses listed on the schedule. This should be courses which are of special interest to you

3. Plan your yearly schedule

Most part-time students take one class per term (five courses per year) and complete their program in approximately two years.

Most full-time students take two or three classes per term and complete their program in 12 months.

4. Consult your advisor

Each student should consult with his/her academic advisor to discuss his/her program. Check the term's definitive course schedule for changes for days and times of the week.
